Zia-ur-Rehman Farooqi, a resident of a nearby village, was arrested at gunpoint after he fired on troops who were patrolling in Dasu area of the province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, a police official told The Associated Press. A nearby army patrol fired back, wounding Farooqi, who sustained bullet wounds to his leg, the official said. Police said he was planning to hand himself in to the authorities. A car containing Farooqi's remains was retrieved from a nearby canal, the official said. The Pakistani Taliban — considered to be the country's most dangerous insurgent group, which has long targeted the army — claimed responsibility for the attack. The militant group, however, claimed responsibility for only one of a wave of more than a dozen recent attacks in the region, including two that killed at least 31 people in Pakistan's second-largest city of Peshawar, according to officials and police. Militants have launched a wave of attacks since early January in the country's volatile northwestern tribal regions, home to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province. The current wave of violence has killed more than 300 people since the start of January, according to Interior Ministry figures. The Taliban claimed responsibility for Tuesday's attack 82157476af
